### ● Rice Cooking Experience

From chopping wood to cooking with a traditional kitchen stove, and even using rice washing water as a substitute for detergent for cleaning, you can experience traditional life from the rice-producing Uwa area.

Fee: 500 yen per person

Rice and other ingredients are not included in the fee

What to bring: rice (6 cups or more), ingredients for miso soup, etc.

You can experience the traditional laundry system with a washboard (for handkerchiefs, socks, etc.).

Fee: 200 yen per person
